Professional Experience

Mr. Murchie has been a licensed practicing architect since 1975 and a principal of SMNG A Ltd. since 1986. He has served as principal-in-charge of several significant projects for community based not-for-profit agencies in Chicago. Among the most notable of these projects are the 70,000 square foot Erie Community Center which features primary health care and child day care facilities in a former manufacturing building, the 22,000 square foot Howard Brown Health Center and the Infant Welfare Society of Chicago, a 38,000 square foot primary care health center. Over the past decade, Mr. Murchie has directed the campus master planning and the design of several new buildings for the Ox-Bow School of Art and Artists' Residency in Saugatuck, Michigan. The new buildings at Ox-Bow include the Inn and Dormitory, Marshall Dormitory, Metternich Lodge, Janie Dormitory, Lutz Painting Studio, and Works on Paper Studio.
